Today, in response to a growing concern regarding the COVID-19 virus, Putnam County Executive MaryEllen Odell declared a state of emergency and all schools in the county will be closed for at least the next week. As per a policy recently drafted by the Brewster Library Board of Trustees, the library will be closed for at least that period of time as well. It is clear that officials and county medical personnel feel that complete closure of community institutions is required to prevent the spread of this illness.
